



Blue Recycling Bins at Loading Dock

Recyclables should be carried to the designated area of the loading dock.

- Recyclables can be contained in brown paper grocery bags or placed in the container loose.
- All items for recycling should be rinsed (*if applicable*) before being placed in the recycling container.
- There is no need to remove any lids or labels.

ACCEPTABLE for Commingled Recycling

Paper

Newspaper & newspaper inserts
Magazines & catalogs
Brown paper bags (*grocery type*)
Junk mail & envelopes
Cardboard (*no wax cardboard boxes*)
Carrier Stock (*soda & beer can carrying cases*)
Office Paper (*white & colored papers, envelopes, copy & fax paper*)
Boxboard (*cereal, food & gift boxes*)
Aseptic packing (*milk cartons & juice boxes*)
Paper back books (*including telephone books, no hard cover books*)



Plastic

Milk, juice & detergent containers
Soda, juice & water containers
Health, beauty products & household cleaners
Margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups
6 and 12 pack rings
Yogurt cups, ketchup bottles & syrup bottles
Narrow neck containers

Glass

Glass jars & bottles (*no windows or ceramics*)

Metal

Aluminum cans, foil & trays
Tin & steel cans (*rinsed*)

UNacceptable for Commingled Recycling

Paper

Paper plates, paper towels, paper napkins
Ice cream cartons

Plastic

Plastic bags (*plastic sheets, tarps or wrap*)
Plastic other than bottles (*items like clear plastic strawberry containers*)
Styrofoam (*expanded foam or clear polystyrene*)

Other

Food waste or food tainted items
Aerosol cans
Pots & pans
Garbage
Motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers
